

MINUTES OF THE SPECIAL MEETING
OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF
THE CITY OF BELLE MEADE

MARCH 7, 2007

A special meeting of the Commissioners of the City of Belle Meade convened at City Hall, 4705 Harding Road, Nashville, Tennessee on Wednesday, March 7, 2007 at 9:00 a.m. to consider the purchase of a small pick-up truck by the City. Those present were: Mayor George Crook, Vice Mayor Thomas Corcoran, Public Works Superintendent George Bartlett and City Manager Beth Reardon.

Mayor Crook presided over the meeting and called for consideration of the request for the City to purchase a used 2004 Toyota Tacoma, 4-cylinder, pick-up truck for \$9,500. Mayor Crook explained that the truck was needed for use by Larry Smith in the Public Works Department for service calls. Mr. Smith has been using an old patrol car from the Police Department that is worn out, and a smaller more fuel-efficient vehicle is needed for service calls. After discussion, Vice Mayor Corcoran moved for approval of the purchase. Mayor Crook seconded the motion. Upon vote, the motion was approved.

There being no further business to come before the Commissioners, the Meeting was thereupon adjourned.
