

**ORDINANCE 2011-3**  
AN ORDINANCE AMENDING 15-126  
OF THE BELLE MEADE MUNICIPAL CODE

BELT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF BELLE MEADE, as follows: \

On the recommendation of the Board of Commissioners, the City of Belle Meade acts to amend its Municipal Code, Title 15, Chapter 1, Section 126 of the Belle Meade Municipal Code, entitled "Baby carriages, strollers and bicycle-drawn carts prohibited on Belle Meade Boulevard" that currently reads as follows:

**Baby carriages, strollers and bicycle-drawn carts prohibited on Belle Meade Boulevard.**

(a) Excepting only designated cross-walks at intersections and the necessary distance between a resident's home and the nearest intersection, the practice of people walking and jogging infant children in baby carriages, strollers and/or through the use of bicycle drawn carts on the paved surface or shoulders of Belle Meade Boulevard is strictly prohibited.

To acknowledge that the City of Belle Meade may designate pedestrian and bicycle lanes on parts of Belle Meade Boulevard, and that such lanes would be available for use by people walking and jogging infant children in baby carriages, stroller and bicycle-drawn carts if such persons have independently made the determination that they can do so safely. Accordingly, the ordinance is amended to read:


**Baby carriages, strollers and bicycle-drawn carts prohibited on Belle Meade Boulevard.**


(b) Excepting only in designated pedestrian and bike lanes, designated cross-walks at intersections and the necessary route between a resident's home and the nearest intersection or pedestrian or bike lane, the practice of people walking and jogging infant children in baby carriages, strollers and/or through the use of bicycle drawn carts on the paved surface or shoulders of Belle Meade Boulevard is strictly prohibited.

Section 2: This Ordinance shall become effective fifteen days after its passage.
